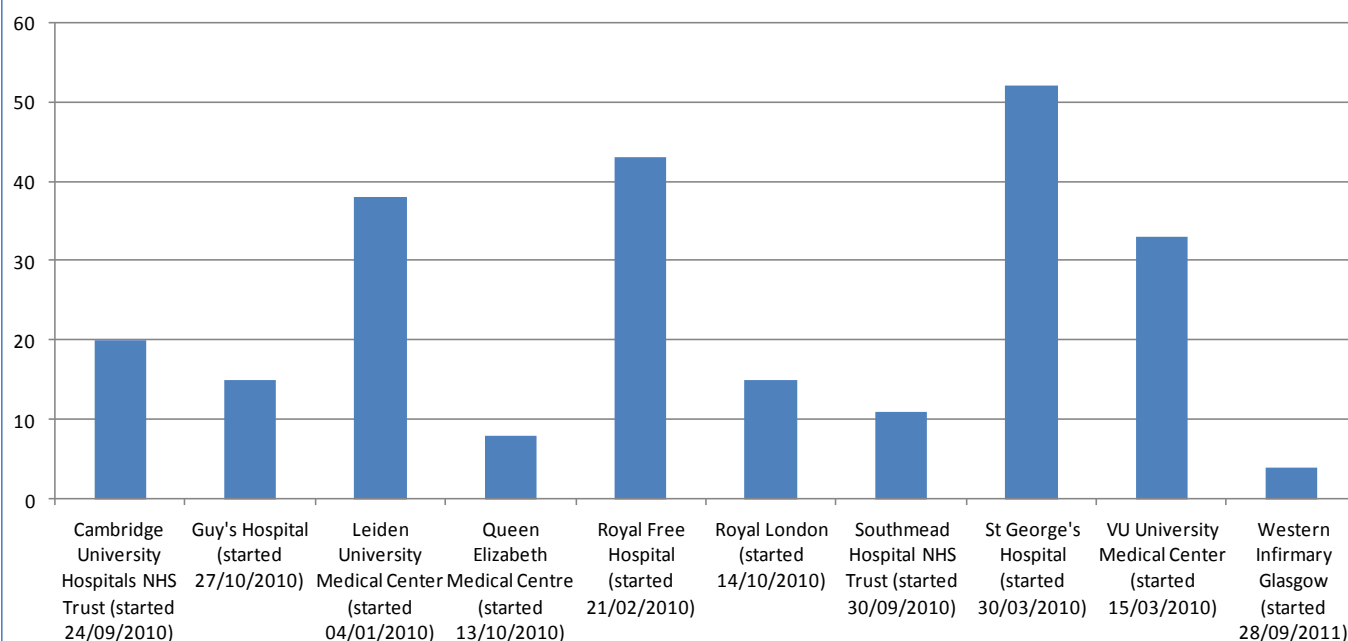

239 randomised to
end of December 2011



Happy new year everyone

2011 was a good year for recruitment finishing with 239 pairs recruited at the end of December. We look forward to continuing this rate of recruitment throughout 2012.

Trial Steering Committee (TSC) meeting

The REPAIR trial steering committee had their last meeting in central London on Tuesday 6th December, which went extremely well. The main issue that was discussed was recruitment and ideas were put forward with regard to approaching more sites. We have had some recent interest from one site in Cardiff and another in Belgium. Hopefully they will both consider coming on board.

The next meeting of the TSC will be in December 2012 and we would like to take this opportunity to thank all the committee members for giving up their valuable time to support the trial.

Data Monitoring Committee (DMC) meeting

The DMC are meeting on 27 January 2012 to review the progress of the trial and the data collected so far. It is very important that the eCRF is up to date especially with regard to the 1 year follow-up and iohexol data. Please ensure that all data due during this period are entered as soon as possible after the appointment has taken place in order to be included for the meeting. We will report back any recommendations or comments made later in the year.
